


Lindsey Nicole Henry Scholarship: A Guide for Parents & Students

The Lindsey Nicole Henry (LNH) Scholarship allows qualifying Oklahoma students to apply for a school voucher to attend an eligible private school of their parents'/guardians' choice.

The LNH Scholarship helps parents/guardians cover the cost of tuition and fees at one of the state's approved private schools. Enacted in 2010, this law has changed countless lives.

DEADLINES



Applications that are approved before the school year starts each Fall receive the fully funded scholarship amount.

*The LNH Scholarship is pro-rated if the applicant is approved after the school year begins.

The deadline is December 1st for each academic year. For example, the deadline for the 2025-2026 academic year is December 1, 2025. Applications received after December 1 are processed for the following academic year. If the child enrolls in and attends the approved private school before the scholarship is granted, the parent will be responsible for tuition charges prior to the approval date.

By The Numbers

- The average LNH Scholarship value was \$7,867 during the 2023-2024 year (OSDE FY 2024 Data Table).
- Approximately 125,000
 Oklahoma students are eligible to apply for a LNH Scholarship.

Currently, 101 private schools across
Oklahoma are approved to serve students
who receive LNH.
