IEP Checklist

Are present levels of performance clear?
How are service minutes being met?
What curriculum, tools & strategies are being used? How is data being taken & who is taking it?
What are the placement options (full continuum of placement)?
Do you need any additional data to make the best decisions?
How are accommodations & modifications implemented? What is everyone's role to make that happen?
Is there a CLEAR parent input statement?
What further training is needed to make the IEP happen (for both parents & teachers)?
Do we need to look at further options for inclusion?
Do we need to look at further options for technology?
Do the IEP goals make sense and apply to the real world?

HELPFUL HINTS

- Show a short video or bring a photo of your child to help everyone remember why they're at the IEP table!
- Try to stay as factual and nonemotional as possible (easier said than done, we know)!
- Small changes lead to big results!
